






DIKW-pyramid (Rowley, 2007)



Knowledge translation pathway

KNOWLEDGE TRANSLATION =

exchange

synthesis

A fundamental unit of KT that is:

interpreting findings or results in

The two-way sharing of knowledge between research producers and users. It may incorporate "integrated KT". featuring and users as partners in

the research process.

application

Often called 'implementation', application refers to putting research into practice, policy and/or action. Attempts should be made to use theory to inform application.

dissemination

Sometimes referred to as 'end-of-grant KT', dissemination sefers to the communication or sharing of research results.










Case study GBD







To what extend are GBD results being used in your country for research?





